Creator History

Henry Colburn was a British bookseller and publisher, known for his assertive marketing practices; he issued works by William Godwin, Mary Shelley, and Benjamin Disraeli, among others. Colburn also founded and edited the *New Monthly Magazine* (1814), the *Literary Gazette* (1817), and the *United Service Journal and Naval and Military Magazine* (1829).
