- To Martin Archer Shee, portrait painter and writer : 1 autograph letter signed : 11 Feb 1836 : (SHEE 0061f) : 1 1/\_ pages (single sheet) : from Wimpole Street : begins, "I would be superfluous to express the sense of gratification I have received in the hojnour conferred on me by the Royal Academy ..." Mounted in the Martin Archer Shee Autograph Album. Filed with bound manuscript volumes under "Shee."
