## Scope and Content Note

· Autograph signatures on verso of indenture agreement : [circa 14 Apr 1800] : (S'ANA 0101h) : 1 page (folded parchment sheet) : legal document regarding the Shelleys and the sale of an estate in Balcombe. Filed under "Timothy Shelley."

· To Percy Bysshe Shelley, poet : 1 letter (secretarial copy) : 23 Oct 1811 : (S'ANA 0127) : 1 page (double sheet) : from 10 Gt. Jas. St. : begins, "Your letter of the 20th inst. came to my hands after the post of yesterday . . ."; conveying to him his father's decision to supply no more money.

· To John Slatter, plumber and glazier : 1 autograph letter signed : 15 Jan 1823 : (S'ANA 0280) : 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> pages (double sheet) : from 3 Kings Road : begins, "Sir Tim. Shelley has sent me your letter and

papers enclosed therein . . ."; regarding money Slatter claims he advanced to Percy Bysshe Shelley.

Also held are manuscript accounts in unidentified hands calculating fees for work done by Whitton for the Shelleys : for 19 Jan 1811 through 24 Dec 1811 (S'ANA 0107); for 24 Oct 1829 through 8 Aug 1831 (S'ANA 0097a-b). Filed under "Shelleyana."
