Abstract: Originals letters, holographs and typescripts, written primarily to Serge Diaghilev, covering many aspects of his life. The focal points of the collection are letters from Lady Juliet Duff and a group of letters from Lady Rothermere and Lord Rothermere business associates, Ernest Outhwaite and William Luck Warden. These letters show how Diaghilev financed his company, particularly the 1928 and 1929 London seasons.

Creator History

Serge_i Pavlovich Dyagilev was born in the province of Novgorod on March 31, 1872. In 1890 he came to St. Petersburg as a law student and soon became a member of the circle of young musicians, painters, and writers assembled around Alexander Benois and Léon Bakst. In the same year of 1899 in which he co-founded the progressive art magazine "Mir Iskoustva" ("The World of Art"), Dyagilev was appointed artistic advisor of the Maryinsky Theatre, where he was in charge of the publication of the theatre annual and of the highly successful productions of "Sadko" and "Sylvia." He resigned from his post in 1901, and after the magazine stopped appearing in 1904, he concentrated on organizing exhibitions of Russian art in St. Petersburg and Paris.

In 1908 Dyagilev brought a production of "Boris Godunov" to Paris with Chaliapin and was then invited to present a Paris season of Russian opera and ballet in 1909. With some of the best dancers from St. Petersburg and Moscow he scored a unique triumph in May and June 1909 in Paris. Repeat visits during the following years led to the gradual formation of his Ballets Russes, which became an independent private company when Vaslav Nijinsky resigned from the Maryinsky Theatre. He directed les Ballets Russes until his death on August 19, 1929, in Venice. His company, financed solely by the European aristocracy, was often on the verge of bankruptcy and never returned to Russia after the October Revolution (nor did it ever perform there).

Scope and Content Note

Originals letters, holographs and typescripts, written primarily to Serge Diaghilev, covering many aspects of his life. The focal points of the collection are letters from Lady Juliet Duff and a group of letters from Lady Rothermere and Lord Rothermere business associates, Ernest Outhwaite and William Luck Warden. These letters show how Diaghilev financed his company, particularly the 1928 and 1929 London seasons. Among the correspondents are Anton Dolin, P. J. S. Richardson, Ruth Page, Constant Lambert, Cyril Beaumont, Cole Porter, Dorothy Coxon, Rupert Doone, William Walton, Sacherverell Sitwell, Lady Sibyl Colefax, Celia and Saxton Nobel, and Mary Hoyt Wiborg. The arrangement within the series is alphabetical, with separate folders for those with significant amounts of correspondence. The last folder has the list of contents that came with the collection. Language of material: English, French, Russian.
