**Abstract:** The Adah Fogel papers contain correspondence and literary translations, 1949-1969. Most of the material pertains to Fogel's research for Irving Howe in preparation for his book *World of our Fathers*. The collection contains seven letters from Howe (1968-1969 and undated), along with two from David Rudkin pertaining to a proposed Royal Shakespeare Company production of *The Golem*. Also included is Mrs. Fogel's translation of *Zavl Rimer* by her father, Menahem Boraisha, a writer and editor for the American Jewish Congress
