Abstract: Susan B. Anthony was an American abolitionist and militant agitator for female and Negro suffrage, temperance, and civil rights. The papers consist of a check from New York Tribune with "Pay Susan B. Anthony" on the back; a copy of "The History of Woman Suffrage" annotated by Anthony; a letter to Editor of "The Tribune" dated 27 Jul. 1881; two letters to Charles Nordhoff offering news items or notices for publication; and several pamphlets relating to Anthony's suffragist activities
