The volume also includes miscellaneous accounts, recorded from 1849 to 1859 Various persons were associated in the business, including B. C. Flannagan, William C. Lipscomb, S. B. Brown, Robert Richardson, H. Davis, W. H. Goodwin, and D. E. Hickman
